

BRAMSHOTT & LIPHOOK PARISH PLAN

MINUTES OF AN EXTRAORDINARY STEERING GROUP MEETING

Held in the Millennium Centre on 19th March 2014 at 1930 hours

1.	<p><u>Introduction.</u> The Chairman introduced Eve Hope, and pointed out the article in the Petersfield Post highlighting our planned consultation programme.</p> <p><i>[After Note: The front page of this week's Liphook Herald also carried a similar article with photograph.]</i></p>	
2.	<p><u>Progress Reports.</u> EH gave a brief on:</p> <p>a. Health, Social & Welfare. She had held meetings with Home Start in Bordon, Sure Start and with Children Centre Groups (HQ Petersfield) in the Millennium Centre. There are 2 hostels in Liphook, one housing 12 families and the other 8. She has attended meetings with the young mothers, which are held weekly in the Guide Hall. The main issues identified so far have been</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Housing – she found a family of 4: 2 adults and 2 children, sharing a one bedroom flat. Since the Father worked in Liphook any move outside the village would create financial problems. Some mothers and children were sharing just one room thereby severely disrupting the children's routine. • Citizen's Advice Bureau (CAB) – a noticeable increase in demand for advice on benefit entitlement, housing, debt and employment. The Liphook branch are seeking to implement an outreach programme, and there were questions being raised over the bedroom tax. <p>In summary Liphook and Grayshott, despite its affluent status, do have pockets of deprivation and a need for more social housing.</p> <p>b. Unemployment. She now plans to visit Job Centre Plus in Petersfield to establish the needs of the unemployed.</p>	
3.	<p><u>Review/audit of Environment Section.</u> These minutes reflect the points raised at the meeting and annotated notes received from members who could not attend:</p> <p>a. General. AP stated that he had made some changes to this section and has incorporated suggestions from CO. He agreed to pass these to the Chairman shortly.</p> <p>b. Paragraph 13.3.4. AB suggested that we should include Scheduled Ancient Monuments e.g. Aqueduct and River Wey.</p>	AP

	c. Para. 13.11.3. AB suggested including the Bramshott Lanes Project: long term management of bank top vegetation along the ancient highways.	
4.	<p><u>Review/audit Planning & Development.</u> Similar annotated notes were received from AB prior to the meeting. Ignoring minor corrections the following points were raised and agreed in:</p> <p>a. Para. 15.6. AB suggests inserting the words ‘in addition’ into the third from last sentence. AP sought clarity as to the meaning of ‘minimum’ – it could be interpreted as many more.</p> <p>b. Para. 15.7. Add Ordnance Support Unit to title as well as referring to the site with its new name of Maple Court. The name of the site alongside the railway needs to be included.</p> <p>c. Para. 15.8. Needs to be clarified, CO agreed to redraft.</p> <p>d. Para. 15.9. Delete the words ‘the newly established’ with regard to SDNP. Also delete ‘should therefore be’ from second sentence and add the word ‘is.’</p> <p>e. Para. 15.12. AB has pointed out that the Royal Anchor and the Jacobean door in particular is Grade II listed. It was also agreed that reference to Wellington & Blucher be deleted.</p> <p>f. Para. 15.18. Add Maple Court.</p> <p>g. Para. 15.22. MP agreed to reword this paragraph.</p> <p>h. Para. 15.23. Delete ‘will form part of’ in last sentence and add ‘is.’</p> <p>i. Para. 15.24. JK is requested to redraft this paragraph.</p> <p>j. Para. 15.38. AB suggests adding the words ‘Army (MoD)’ after National Trust and before land.</p> <p>k. Para 15.40. AB asks if there is any information on Hammer Vale.</p>	<p>CO</p> <p>MP</p> <p>JK</p> <p>JK</p>
5.	<p><u>Agree Community’s Recommendations.</u> The following changes were agreed on:</p> <p>a. Para. 4.26.2. MP agreed to draft suitable alternative wording.</p> <p>b. Para. 11.48. Delete the words ‘Strive to’ in first sentence.</p> <p>c. Para. 12.17. Delete last sentence.</p> <p>d. Para. 12.19. Delete everything after ‘anti-social parking.’</p> <p>e. Para. 12.43 Delete, duplication.</p> <p>f. Environment. AP agreed to include something on Shipwright’s Way, improvements to railway station, SDNP and SSSI protection.</p> <p>g. Para. 15.45. Insert ‘conservation area and’ before historical buildings.</p> <p>h. Para. 18.63. JP agreed to revise the wording in this paragraph to reflect the lack of signage for cyclists by the Canadian underpass.</p> <p>i. Para. 20.39. Chairman to check with Bohunt School to see if the improvements to technical equipment, such as sound and lighting, have been completed.</p> <p>j. Para. 21.1. Consider revising the wording of this and Para. 21.2.</p>	<p>MP</p> <p>AP</p> <p>JP</p> <p>Chairman</p> <p>Chairman</p>

6.	<p><u>Any Other Business.</u></p> <p>a. Work Programme. The Chairman explained that EHDC had booked the Millennium Hall on Tuesday 15th April for a Forum meeting on the JCS. As this would clash with our SG meeting in the Canada Room it was agreed that we would postpone this meeting until 13th May.</p> <p>b. Assets of Community Value. AP asked about the registration of assets of community value.</p> <p>c. Lowsley Farm. There was a brief discussion on the suitability of the lower part of the Farm for sport and recreational facilities.</p>
