In JT's absence this was carried forward.</p> <p>i. Item 7a (3), Tpt8 – Cycling, Military Byelaws. The Chairman explained that he had decided against speaking to the military as this was more of an action, rather than planning matter, at this stage.</p> <p>j. Item 7b, Tpt9 – Car Parking. At the latest Parish Council meeting Cllr Ferris Cowper reported that HCC's parking project remained current and that suitable subcontractors were being researched. The Chairman agreed to obtain a copy of their terms of reference.</p> <p>k. Item 7c, Y1 – Support for Young People. In light of Bohunt's recent announcement of a Sixth Form College in Liphook the Chairman decided against distracting them on this subject.</p> <p>l. Item 7d, Y3 – Personal Development. The Chairman explained that he had spoken to the parish clerk with regard to the maintenance of the Ottawa play area. 5.	<p><u>Chairman's Report.</u> He noted from the papers and EHDC's business website the lack of support being received by the Association of Petersfield Business. It had reached a point where it might have to dissolve. This seems to reflect the experience of the Liphook Business Initiative. He wondered what action would be required to reverse this trend.</p>	
6.	<p><u>Treasurer's Report.</u> No report was presented.</p>	
7.	<p><u>Develop the Action Plan.</u> Through oversight, Action Plan V1.4 was not circulated prior to the meeting. The Chairman therefore gave a brief explanation on each outstanding action point. He then agreed to rewrite the wording in certain areas, update where necessary and circulate version V1.5 for further analysis by members. He would then draft an Executive Summary for consideration.</p>	<p>Chairman</p>
8.	<p><u>Update on Sports &amp; Recreation.</u> The Chairman acknowledged receiving a petition from the treasurer of U3A on behalf of the Boules Club signed by 20 members. They have 2 boules groups which currently play at Liss Forest. They have asked for boules pitches in Liphook and would like this request included in the Parish Plan. It was unanimously agreed that once the size of the pitches were known their requirements would be included.</p>	<p>Chairman</p>
9.	<p><u>Update on Education &amp; Training Section.</u> The Chairman was delighted that Bohunt School now had permission for a Sixth Form, but expressed concern over the impact the increased number of pupils (from the current 1,400 to over 2,100 in 2 or 3 years' time) would have on Liphook. The present infrastructure – roads, parking, facilities etc. – may not be able to cope. He felt that unless action was planned now to meet this known demand problems would arise. As there was insufficient time to write this section – it now becomes a Neighbourhood Plan responsibility – he felt that he should flag up members' concerns rather than just write a short paragraph explaining why this research was incomplete. This was unanimously agreed.</p>
