

## BRAMSHOTT AND LIPHOOK PARISH PLAN

Steering Group meeting 7.30pm Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> June

No one had received minutes of the last meeting but we worked from notes made.

Re the Youth Survey, Trevor said he was working on it but wanted assistance. JT would contact the youth leaders and perhaps arrange a meeting with them

RY was awaiting a reply from Ferris Cowper and from the vicar. He would pursue. He would also ascertain a Governor at Bohunt. JK knew one from the junior school and would make contact. This was so we could find out their development plans for education in Liphook.

RY read a letter he had received from Parish council with their future plans. It was noted that the Railway Station access was missing. RY would write to PC and ask what is happening re this.

We were then joined by a very nice young man Matt Tilley who expressed a very keen interest. We then filled him in on our progress and hopes so far with all the details. He will be delighted to assist Trevor on Youth, Sport and Leisure. We need to ascertain what is needed or wanted to provide for the youth. It was agreed that an open shelter type was wanted as a building would need supervision and be off putting. This will be followed up.

Bohunt is to open a sixth form college which should bring the youth back from Alton to Liphook so we need to plan for this.

Matt was asked if there was any counselling at Bohunt and there was not. This would also be followed up. He also was not aware of Student fares on the Trains, so we need to gather this sort of information and make it available to them individually; he said that hardly anyone looked at notice boards. TM and MT will look at this.

JT said he was having trouble with his new website but was hopeful that it would be up and running soon. He agreed to transfer all the information in the existing one and would be willing to add all the reports he had. All were asked to ensure he had them. . JT also asked for any photos to be sent.

In view of this, A discussion took place re the open day in July and it was agreed that this was too soon so it will be cancelled and rescheduled for September. We agreed that the website must be working and well publicised before the open day so the community can look before they come and be prepared for the day. A provisional booking has been made for the Millennium Hall on Saturday Sept 15<sup>th</sup>.
